January 18 Demonstrator TIMOTHY GENET

Timothy A. Genet is an oil painter born and raised in Southern California. Interested in art at a very young age, he had very little exposure or formal training.

Timothy started painting in 1973 when his wife enrolled him in a painting class. Originally, he worked with a palette knife, producing large studio oils, but in the late 1980's he went searching for a new direction for his art. He traveled to Catalina Island to observe a plein air group working on location. "I asked a lot of questions and watched how they applied the paint," he said. "I was instantly hooked." A week later, Timothy was painting outside, on location.

A world traveler, Tim Genet's California painting style captures the essence of his native California, as well as the many foreign lands he has visited. He has produced paintings in Hawaii, the East Coast, the Mexican Riviera, Europe, the Caribbean, East Africa, and the South Pacific.

In mid 2006, Timothy's work took a new turn, one towards the abstract. He is currently producing a series of "expressive Figurative" works using a palette knife once

again. Focusing on texture, color, gesture and pose, the paintings are absent of any facial details. His goal is to leave the work impressionistic, thus engaging the viewer in the figure's mysteries.
