March 21 Demonstrator John Paul Thornton

We are proud to announce that John Paul Thornton has come back to us for a return engagement. His demonstration last year was very meaningful and tremendously popular.

Painting and humanity are two of John Paul's great passions. While demonstrating portrait painting in oils, John Paul will share emotional true stories of his recent experiences in Haiti, creating art workshops for refugee children with the United Nations Foundation in Port-au-Prince's largest tent city. Color theory, brushwork, design, and varieties of edges will be covered in his demonstration.

John Paul is the author of the book, *Art and Courage: Stories to Inspire the Artist-Warrior Within*. His art projects have taken him around the world: to India, Nepal, China, Japan, Mexico and throughout Europe. His paintings have been exhibited at the Lincoln Memorial in Washington, DC, and he has been honored by CBS television, the California Senate and the United States Congress.

As an acknowledged expert teacher and award-winning professional painter, he regularly conducts workshops and lectures to audiences around the globe. His next project is taking him to Tokyo.

Margarite E. Lee Gallery Competition

1. The competition for the Margarite E. Lee Gallery shall be held in the months of September, December, March and May.
2. Entrants must be a member in good standing with paid membership dues.
3. Entrants must be present at the meeting or their artwork will not be displayed.
4. Only one entry is allowed per member.
5. Entries must not have been a winner in a previous Margarite E. Lee competition.
6. Entries must be registered to enter the competition.
7. All entries must be submitted by 7:30PM as entries arriving after that time will not be accepted.
8. Once submitted, all entries must remain hung at least until the next monthly meeting. No artwork may be removed or changed at any other time, although we'd like all artwork to remain until the following judging period.
9. All entries must be framed and properly wired, and no saw tooth hangers will be accepted.
10. No artwork shall weigh more than 25 pounds.
11. All entries shall be judged in a single category.
12. First, second and third place ribbons will be awarded.
13. Points shall be awarded as follows. First place: 7 points; Second place: 5 points; Third place: 3 points; Entry only: 1 point. These points will count towards the artist's point total in their respective division for Artist of the Year.

Don't forget to bring a second piece to the next meeting.
