



November 21 Demonstrator FRANK EBER

Frank Eber is a watercolorist who paints uniquely fresh and atmospheric paintings that have a dreamy quality to them. He is known for his loose and magical plein air work. He is a Signature Member of the National Watercolor Society and has won awards in many international shows. He was awarded the Alden Bryan Memorial Medal at the prestigious American Watercolor Society's 2012 Annual Exhibition in New York City. His paintings were also featured in the June, 2012 issue of Watercolor Artist Magazine, in Splash 14 (North Light Books, 2013), and on the cover of the Daniel Smith Summer catalog.

Although he now lives in Redondo Beach, Frank grew up in Europe and was mentored by Italian master painter Renato Casaro in the early 1990s. His work is currently exhibited in local as well as national shows and he is a Vice President of the National Watercolor Society. His love of travel has given him prime opportunities to paint fabulous scenes. He lived in the south of France for two years and has painted on location in Italy, the Netherlands, Austria, Switzerland, Germany and the Czech Republic.

In his blog on the web, Frank gives great advice on a number of painting issues. Talking about painting edges, for instance, he notes that he like to see all conceivable edges in his watercolors, not just wet-on-wet or wet-on-dry. "Many people only have control of the two, most aren't ever aware that there are more!" he says. "The most elusive edge is probably the one that gives you fuzzy, controlled soft edges.....a common mistake is to carry too much water on the brush."
