Genevieve has been conducting a monthly class for girls at Juvenile Hall for a number of years. The girls there are runaways, prostitutes and drug users. They have little or no semblance of normality in their lives. A bright spot comes once a month when Genevieve runs an art session where they paint or draw a greeting, holiday or note card, make an envelope and mail it to a loved one. In addition to the gratitude of the teenagers themselves, Genevieve has been repeatedly recognized with a number of Volunteerism awards.

In addition, Bette and Mary will once again be conducting art sessions for the kids at the Boys and Girls Club and the community at large. The sessions will take place every Tuesday during the month of July from 12:30-2.30pm in the same room where the painting workshop is held. The painting workshop will resume in August.
