
### October's Visiting Artist: Pete Morris \* Watercolor

Pete Morris draws and paints the world around him as he sees it, neighborhood scenes, local landmarks, downtown workers, people on the Metro trains, people he knows, people in coffee shops musicians at concerts, and travels in Guatemala, Japan and on Rte 66. He involves others in his art, teaching multiple drawing and painting classes and offering demos and workshops to art associations.

Pete has had exhibits of his paintings at various venues, including Azusa Pacific University, the Mor York Gallery in Los Angeles, Creative Arts Group in Serra Madre, Vroman's Brookstore Pasadena, Pasadena Seniors Center, Sierra Madre City Hall and South Pasadena library.

A YouTube video entitled "Pete Morris the Metro Da Vinci" tells the story of Pete's ongoing practice of drawing people on the Metro trains and another one, "Pete Morris: An Artist in the O.R.:, documents him sketching in the operating room during a medical mission.
