Be advised that this is a juried show. In the event that there are more entries than there is space to hang them, some work will be juried out by the Show Juror. Entry fees are nonrefundable.

Please read and comply with the show rules as they relate to the work as non-compliance will result in artwork not being accepted for display.



There is limited parking on Anaheim Blvd. and Broadway. If you park on Center Street Promenade, check the parking signs carefully. It is easiest to park in the parking structure off Center Street Promenade. Go through the gate on the second floor of the parking structure and get a ticket. Bring the

ticket to the MuseO cashier and they will validate it for parking. There is a walking entrance from the Center Street Promenade to the Gallery. Use the back entrance on the West side of the Carnegie Gallery (the front entrance on Anaheim Blvd will be locked).

Rick J. Delanty's oil and acrylic landscape paintings are focused on God's divine power, as revealed in His creation. Collectors love the vibrant color and energy apparent in his paintings.

At this year's Plein Air Convention in San Francisco, Rick was selected as a teaching Faculty member and Field Painter. Recently at the Laguna Invitational, Rick received the Spirit of Laguna and the Lifetime Achievement awards. Rick has also won the Boseker and the Surfrider awards there. This year he was honored to be in the CAC Gold Medal Show. National exhibitions include American Impressionist Society, Oil Painters of America, and National Society of Painters in Casein and Acrylic. As an invited artist, he has participated in the Sedona, San Luis Obispo, Borrego Springs and Maui Plein Air. Rick enjoys being a juror, demonstrator and workshop instructor. He has won awards at the Salmagundi Club in New York, the Laguna Art Museum, Best of Show in International Society of Acrylic Painters and second prize in the plein air category of the Art Renewal Center's 2016 international show. His work is included in the permanent collection of the Coutts Museum, and the Irvine Museum.

Signature membership includes the American Impressionist Society, Laguna Plein Air Painters Association, International Society of Acrylic Painters, Plein Air Artists of Colorado, and California Plein Air Painters. He is an Artist member of the California Art Club, and member of the National Watercolor Society. Rick is represented in California by the Santa Barbara Fine Art Gallery, and in Utah by Mission Fine Art Gallery.

- Only 2 dimensional work accepted
- All work must be original. No class work and none done under instruction. No giclee' or other prints will be allowed. *No copies, reproductions, interpretation or studies of another artist's work will be accepted into the competition. Sourced referenced materials, i.e. photographs, may only be used with written approval from the photographer or the artwork is not eligible.
- No restrictions to date completed.
- All work must be framed or painted gallery wrapped.
- Artists will not be permitted to submit more than (4) four entries. Some pieces of art may not be accepted into the show by the Jurors. In this eventuality, we will notify you and you must pick up your art promptly. AAA will not be responsible for work not picked up within 48 hours of notification.
- No wet paintings.
- All entries MUST have wire hangers on the back. NO saw tooth hangers will be accepted.
- Size limit is 43" in either direction including the frame.
- Name, title, phone number and medium must be on the back.
- A liability and photo release will be required (available on website).

- No entry shall be permitted to have another media on top of a photograph, print or giclee'.
- There must be at least 12 entries in each category or they will be combined with the next smallest category.
- No piece shall receive more than one award and no artist will receive more than three awards. Exception:the Mayor's Award could be awarded to a piece that has received an award from the juror.
- Any artwork that has won an award in any prior Anaheim Art Association Open is not eligible for entry into this event, except if it only won an Honorable Mention.
- MuzeO will handle all sales and will retain a 30% commission for all sales during the show.
- The AAA show chairman will resolve all questions concerning entries, categories, or submissions.
- Any violation of these rules will lead to disqualification and removal from the show.
- All Artwork must remain on display until the end of the show and must be picked up at the end of the awards ceremony on Sunday, October 20th .
- All artists must sit the gallery for at least one (1) 3 hour shift on a Friday, Saturday or Sunday during the show.
